



7 DAYS – 6 NIGHTS LAND OF ANATOLIA

DAY 1 – ISTANBUL - BURSA L,D KIRICI HOTEL (243 KM)

Arrival to Istanbul Ataturk airport and our staff will transfer you to Bursa southwest of the Sea of Marmara, The city derives its name from its founder Prusias, King of Bithynia. It subsequently came under Roman, then Byzantine rule before falling to Osman Bey in 1326 becoming the first capital of the Ottoman Empire. Many important Ottoman buildings remain. Bursa was, and still is famous for its silk trade, towel manufacture and thermal springs. Shopping at the silk market then check in hotel and overnight in Bursa.

DAY 2 – BURSA – PAMUKKALE B,L,D LYCUS VILLA HOTEL (444 KM)

After breakfast visit, Ulu Mosque (Grand mosque) was constructed in the Seljuk style. A finely carved walnut mumber and impressive calligraphic panels decorate the mosque. Visit Uludag (sky center) by car or cable car (teleferik). is the largest winter sport center in Turkey. After lunch drive to Pamukkale as a magical and spectacular natural site and one of the unique places in the world; Pamukkale (Hierapolis) is a fairyland of dazzling white, petrified castle. Thermal spring waters laden with calcareous salts running off the plateau's edge have created this fantastic formation of stalactites, cataracts and basins. The hot springs have been used by the Roman times for their therapeutic powers. Both the thermal center with its motels and thermal pools and the ruins of ancient city of hierapolis are situated on the plateau. Another thermal center northwest of Pamukkale, Karhayit is known for its water's high-iron content. Dinner and overnight in Pamukkale.

DAY 3 – PAMUKKALE – KONYA B,L,D OZKAYMAK HOTEL (415 KM)

After breakfast, we drive to Konya city and visit the mausoleum of Mevlana, Konya (Iconuim) is renowned for Mevlana Celaledin Rumi. Mevlana is one of the greatest Islamic sufists and the founder of the Mevlevi Sufi Order. His religion was based on good, charity, humanity, love and union with God. For Mevlana, poetry, music and dance were indispensable for the perfection of the soul. Mevlana's greatest work, Mesnevi, is a collection of 25,000 poems. The Museum house contain of his tomb, a collection of precious manuscripts, antique carpets, musical instruments and garments. It also includes the dervishes lodges. Dinner and overnight in Konya.

DAY 4 – KONYA - CAPPADOCIA B,L,D VERA TASSARAY HOTEL (221 KM)

After breakfast drive to Cappadocia violent eruptions of the volcanoes that came from Erciyes Mountain and Hasan Mountain three million years ago, covered the surrounding plateau with tuff. From this brittle rock the wind and rain have eroded Cappadocia 's spectacular, surrealist landscape of rock cones, capped pinnacles and fretted ravines, in colors ranging from warm reds and gold to cool greens and greys. After lunch shopping at carpet & porcelain, tile center In the afternoon we visit underground city of Ozkonak, and onto Ortahisar and Avanos. Dinner and overnight in Cappadocia.

DAY 5 – CAPPADOCIA – BOLU– ISTANBUL B,L,D CARLTON HOTEL (730 KM)

Early morning drive to Istanbul on the way to Istanbul we will stop at Bolu mountain. Bolu is the regional center for the western Black Sea region, region as rich in the history of the Byzantine period as the ancient remains of the Greek and Roman periods in the south west. Check in hotel for dinner and overnight in Istanbul.



DAY 6 – ISTANBUL B,L,D CARLTON HOTEL

After breakfast we will pick-up you at the hotel for visit Topkapi Palace, former residence of Ottoman Sultans. Visit the Blue Mosque 1606, famous for its architecture as for its blue tiles. Visit the Byzantine Hippodrome, where chariot races were held. Visit the Grand Bazaar world’s largest with 4000 shops + numerous of alleys. Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.

DAY 7 – ISTANBUL B,L,D

After breakfast free at the leisure and will be transferred to the airport.
